Paper 2, Elizabethan England

You will evaluate the impact of Elizabeth I's accession to the throne and problems. You will explain the Royal Court, government and Privy Council. You will evaluate the impact of Essex's Rebellions, the marriage questions and the succession crisis. You will analyse the impact of new discoveries, changes in fashion, food and sport and developments in theatre. You will assess the causes of the Elizabethan Poverty Crisis and the Poor Law response.

Conflict and tension: the inter-war years, 1918–1939 – Hitler's rise to power and aims

You will examine Hitler's aim and how these lead to war. You will evaluate the impact of the remilitarisation of the Rhineland, 1938 Anschluss, the Sudeten Crisis, the ending of appeasement, the Nazi-Soviet Pact and responsibility for WW2.

Paper 1: Conflict and Tension, the Inter-War Years: 1918-1939

You will examine the impact of the Armistice and terms of the Versailles Treaty, the aims of the Big Three and reactions to the Treaty. You will evaluate the impact of the League of Nations, the Manchurian Crisis, the Abyssinian Crisis and the rise of extremist parties.

Paper 2, Health and the People: c1000 to Present Day

You will evaluate the impact of Cholera and John Snow, the influencers of public health changes, Fleming Florey and Chain's developments, penicillin, Watson and Crick, Booth and Rowntree, the Liberal government, WW2, Bevan and the NHS and changes in public health in modern Britain.

Paper 2, Health and the People: c1000 to Present Day

You will evaluate the impact of John Hunter, the growth of hospitals, public health in early modern Britain, the 1665 Plague, the developments of inoculations and vaccinations and the overall medical progress in the Renaissance. You will also evaluate the impact of the Industrial Revolution, Germ Theory, magic bullets, Lister and Simpson and public health in industrial Britain.



PAPER 1 America 1920-1973: Opportunity and Inequality
 You will describe the impact of WWI, Henry Ford and Mass Production, the American Boom, the inequalities of wealth and the The Roaring 20s. You will evaluate the impact of the 19th Amendment and women's rights, flappers, Prohibition and the impact of Al Capone, Communists, Anarchists and the Palmer Raids, the causes of Immigration and the case of Sacco and Vanzetti. You will analyse the impact of the Jim Crow Laws and racial tension, the rise and fall of the KKK and the effects of the Wall Street Crash.

 You will assess the failures of the rebellions and the role of Mary Queen of Scots. You will evaluate the causes of the conflict with Spain the Spanish Armada and the death of Elizabeth. You will also explore the named Historical Environment.
